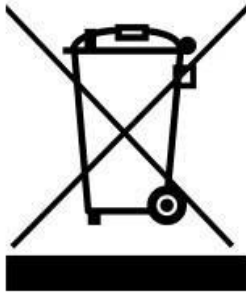


THE PROCEDURE WITH USED UP ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

1. Each customer can leave used up device in a store in which they bought new device as the store is obliged to take back the old device without any charge if a new device of the same type and function will be bought in it.
2. Each customer can give back used up electrical and electronic equipment at the place of delivery. According to the existing legislation the distributor by delivering to the buyer (customer) devices intended for households is obliged to take back the old device without any charge at the place of delivery if the used up device is of the same type and function as the new device.
3. Each customer can leave used up device in a market without having to buy a new one. According to the existing legislation stores with an sales area of devices intended for households of min. 400 m² are obliged to take back the device in this store or near it, the used up devices from households with any of its external dimensions not exceeding 25 cm, without the need to purchase new devices intended for household use.
4. Each customer can take back used up device to the collection point. The information about nearest localization can be found on your city website or on a notice board of the city / commune. Additionally on the city area of Rzeszow, there are electro waste containers in which used up electrical and electronic equipment can be thrown. The nearest point in Rzeszow is located on Zwirki i Wigury 7 street.

5. If you decide to repair the device in service point and the repair is unprofitable or impossible because of technical reasons, the service point is obliged to take back this device free of charge.
6. Household has a very important role in contributing to the reuse and recovery of waste equipment. A proper procedure with used up devices prevents a potential negative consequences for natural environment and human health.

The devices collected in a way described above goes to specialized processing plants where the dangerous components are removed first. Other elements are subjected to recovery and recycling processes. Each device powered by electricity or batteries should be marked with a symbol of crossed out trash bin.



A symbol of crossed out trash bin placed on the device, package or documents attached means that product cannot be throw out with other waste. The user obligation is to pass used up device to a designated point of selection in order to its proper processing. This symbol also means that the product was placed on the market after August 13th 2005.

Used up devices cannot be thrown out together with other waste! There is a risk of money penalty. A proper procedure with used up devices prevents a potential negative consequences for natural environment and human health.

At the same time we save up natural resources of Earth by reusing the resources from device processing.
